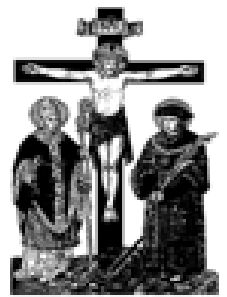

**Receiving Communion**

Since the Covid pandemic, and all the measures that followed to restrict the spread of the illness, fewer and fewer parishioners have wished to receive Holy Communion on their tongue. We of course respect the wishes of those who continue to prefer to receive Holy Communion in this way, but would ask that from now on, they ensure that they receive Holy Communion from Fr. Tim, or any other priest celebrating Mass, by joining his side of the Communion procession. This is because we have a number of Eucharistic Ministers who, for personal or family health reasons, continue to need to minimise the risk of infection either to themselves or to others; unfortunately, that infection risk still remains.

**Car Lifts to Sacred Heart Church**

This consisted of groups of drivers on rotas, taking it in turns to pick up individuals and take them to church.
